To take part to the Pilgrimage of trust in Cotonou is an opportunity to discover Benin today, its challenges, its hopes. In order to meet people in depth, more than reading a lot of information, it is good to dispose yourself and open up in advance to those who will receive you, their lifestyle, their tradition of hospitality....

Expanding our prayer and asking God to prepare us to recognize and welcome the treasures of humanity, sometimes at the heart of the most dramatic situations is a concrete track to start.

Passport and visa:

Medical recommendations:

See your doctor to be sure you leave in good health and seek his advice for your journey and stay. Average temperature in September in Cotonou is 26°C. Mosquitoes are many!

Security:

Participants from the Republic of South Africa (RSA) should check the fee with Taizé.

Travel:

Participants traveling by road should contact their local chaplain for travel arrangements and plan their departure from Cotonou from 3 pm on the 4th of September 2016.
